

Designs: Judy of JBW Designs has published several lovely new designs.

Three traditional Sweet Nothings size, one a larger size and another Stitchalong.

JBW 284 - Antique Vases Sampler: A reproduction of an old sampler (possibly 1820 - 1850) owned by Judy. This sampler has the usual elements - two differently styled alphabets, a set of numbers, rows or parts of rows of pretty patterned bands, motifs of animals and various styled vases filled with flowers and all completely surrounded by a border. A larger piece than Judy's usual little Sweet Nothings designs. \$25.00 JBW 285 - Christmas Pear Tree: Another of Judy's signature designs - that is, the shape of the designed object being created and filled with little motifs of birds, rabbits, reindeer and hearts. This design is a

Christmas tree. And where do the pears fit in? The hanging ornaments on the tree are all little pears! Very clever. \$10.00 (See below - two other motif Christmas tree designs by Judy.)

JBW 286 - Antique Vases Needlework Accessories: The designs for the three needlework accessories - a needlework pocket, a needle case and a scissor fob - are motifs that are from/worked in the lovely sampler described above (Antique Vases Sampler). \$10.00


JBW 287 - Reindeer ABC's: Another Stitchalong design. This time reindeer of all shapes and sizes are dotted between letters of the alphabet. \$18.50 (See below - two other 'Stitchalong' designs and on the previous page, stitched model of ABC's & Christmas Trees)

JBW 288 - Vintage Ornaments: Three little ornamentals to hang on your Christmas tree or dot amongst your swags of Christmas greenery - Santa's sleigh stacked with Christmas gifts and a Christmas tree: ice skates: a train set, a rocking horse and a window adorned with a Christmas wreath. The Christmas tree is embellished with a tiny red star.






