

What's New At Heirlooms?

Designs: Last month I missed including some of Karen Kluba's latest designs. These lovely designs are -
ROSE:DOGWOOD - *Dogwood Lace:* This piece Karen designed to be stitched with one overdyed colour. Also, it is a great piece for you to personalise and so make your own unique piece. For example, add the bride & groom's names or initials and wedding date for a wedding sampler : add the word WELCOME for a welcome sampler : insert family initials in place of some of the motifs for a family tree sampler, etc. Of this design Karen says, "I've always loved seeing the colourful spots of Dogwood trees in the woodlands during the spring: they are another wonder of Mother Nature. This design was adapted from an antique lace pattern as a tribute to the beautiful dogwood trees". \$27.50

ROSE:FLOWERS - *Flowers, Awake!* Rows of different flowers between rows of words that create the verse, "Awake thou wintry earth, Fling off thy sadness, Fair vernal flowers, Laugh forth thou ancient gladness". Of this design, Karen writes, "The lovely verse in this sampler was the inspiration for the design. It is a quote from Thomas Blackburn's 'An Easter Hymn'". \$29.00

ROSE:WELCOME - *Welcome Home:* A very different, but lovely sampler, to have in one's entrance hall of their home. The words on it say, "Welcome to our home". These words are beside a pot containing a flowering plant of 'buttons' - that is, many of the flowers on the plant are represented by a beautiful button. Of this design Karen says, "This design has several fun elements that inspired me - beautiful buttons, lovely over-dyed threads and

creative stitches, all of which add dimension to the finished piece". \$23.00

FABRIC: Because it is Christmas time, it has reminded me to remind you of the lovely Christmas afghan fabric that is in stock. It is called, *Tannenbaum*, which translates into English as, *Christmas Tree*. Each square panel (approximately 14" x 14") is surrounded by a border of Christmas trees and at each corner is a lovely heart. The colour that is in stock is blue.

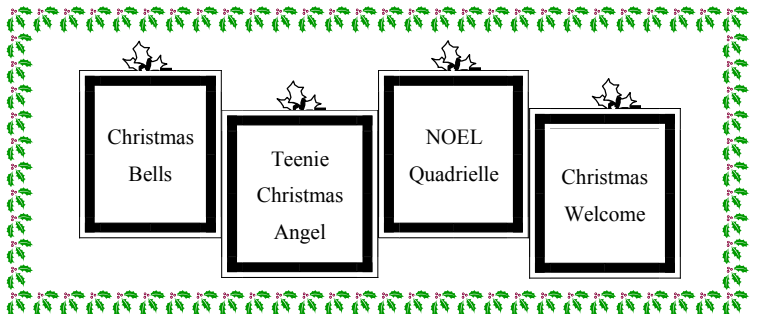

Needlework Models: In the Christmas invitation it was noted that new Christmas models were to be on display during the Christmas period.

Two of the designs have been stitched for a while - but had not been 'made up' at the time of sending the invitation.

These two designs were - *Christmas Welcome* and *NOEL*.

As for the *Christmas Welcome* design, I originally stitched this design over two threads and I attached this to a large cushion. This was on display during the Christmas 2011 period. I subsequently stitched the design again over one thread. Just before opening for this year's Christmas display, I managed to make it up into a little cushion.

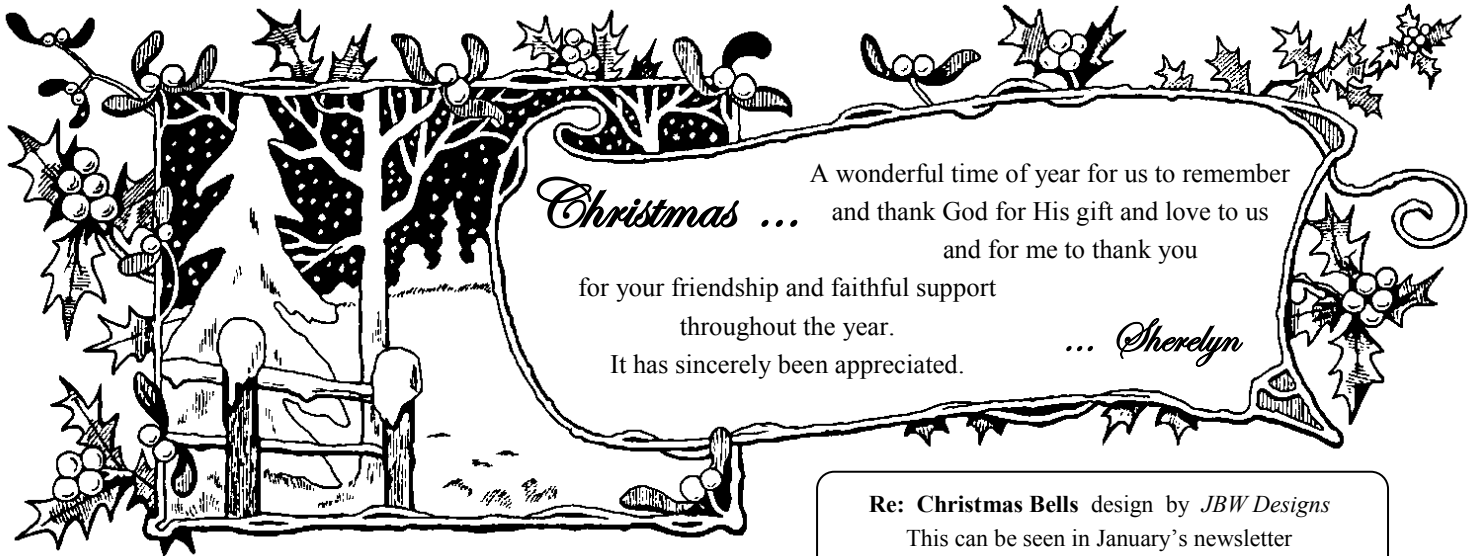

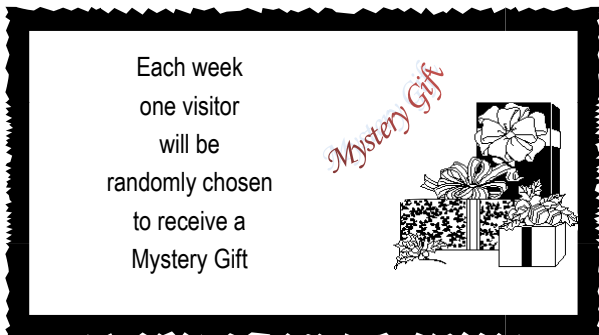
