Dear Needlework Friends,


More travels since my last newsletter written at the beginning of August.



MATERIALS:

FABRIC: Permin Linen - 40 count - Lambswool : 15" x 17.5" (38cm x 44.5cm)

THREADS: Silk 'n Colours by "The "Chread Gatherer" ~ SNC 180 : Belvedere Gardens

DMC Stranded Cottons ~ 718 : 730 : 924 : 3012 : 3033 : 3607

STITCH COUNT: 144w x 180h

FINISHED SIZE: 7.2" x 9.5" (18.5cm x 24cm)

TECHNIQUES: Cross Stitch, Satin Stitch, Four-Sided Stitch, Sheaf, Upright Herringbone, Rhodes Square, Square Eyelets, Chain,

Algerian Eyelets, Diamond Eyelets, Ray Stitch, Rhodes Hearts & Backstitch



Included with the design instructions & charts is a printed symbol drop to add to your ring of needlework threads

This design was inspired by and for the remembrance of a special fried at the time of their passing.

Special thanks to the Darrah family from myself.

Their mother & grandmother, Elizabeth Darrah, was an exceptional needlewoman, needlework designer & businesswoman and a special friend.

We spent many hours sharing our love of needlework as we visited needlework trade shows and toured places, such as Italy, to immerse ourselves in and learn of their needlework history.

The central flower, acorn & carnation in this design is one used by Elizabeth in one of her designs and which the family have given me permission to use in this design for your stitching enjoyment.






