

What's New At Heirlooms?

Designs: As I had so much new content for my last month's newsletter, I decided to feature the new releases by Ellen Chester of *With My Needle* in this April newsletter. Ellen's two newest designs are -

WMN:ADA - Ada Mary Hornsey, 1868: This is a historical reproduction of Ada's sampler which she stitched when she was 10 years old. The verse on this sampler reads, "My father, my mother I know I cannot your kindness repay; But I hope that, as older I grow; I shall learn your commands to obey." (*I wonder why she wrote such a verse was she honouring her parents, or was she made to stitch this sampler as some punishment for some act of childish disobedience?*). Included with the design is a small photo of the antique sampler and research about Ada and her family. The design is worked mainly in cross stitch but has an outer satin stitched border. \$31.00

WMN:ACADEMY - Miss Trenner's Needlework Academy: This includes designs for three embroidered panels, instructions for lining two oval boxes (Shaker or papier-mâché), and designs and instructions for a needle roll and a scissors weight. The largest design is of a three-story house with sheep on the front lawn either side of a path which leads to the house from a sign which reads, *Needlework Academy*. This is a fictitious school, named after a friend of Ellen's. The designs for the other pieces are of two female friends and the sign. Stitches used throughout are alternating backstitch, backstitch, Belgian cross, closed herringbone, cross stitch, four-sided, half cross stitch, herringbone, Montenegrin, Nun's stitch, Rhodes heart, satin and tent stitch. However, if desired, cross stitch can be substituted for many of the specialty stitches. \$40.00


